Project Concept:

The project brings together Southeast Asian music students for a week of collaboration, sharing, and innovation. 15 Lao students and their director will join with 13 Southeast Asian Students to create a performance of 15-20 minutes, which will be presented on Saturday, March 26th at the SEADOM Congress. The project director will be Professor Shane Taylor "Ty" Constante from Yong Siew Toh Conservatory of Music, Singapore and the Laos music director will be an active collaborator.

The performance will be an original presentation featuring both traditional and modern instruments, using Laos folk melodies as a starting point to explore deeper creative works of music.
